Youth Group

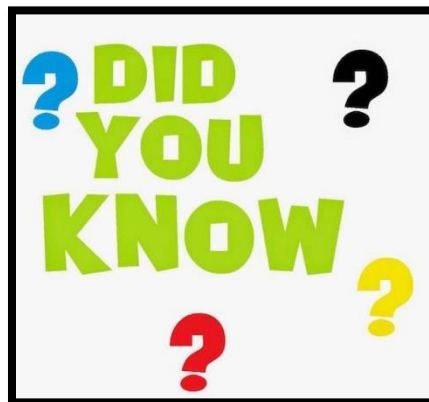
Our Youth Group will meet on October 9th and October 23rd from 5-7pm at the Church.
