Strength for the Day "Let Freedom Ring!" July 2023

Happy Fourth of July! This is the month when we Americans celebrate our freedom, with everything from backyard barbecues to parades to concerts to dazzling displays of fireworks. We may even remember to thank God for our political and economic freedom, even the freedom of speech!

I was cleaning out some old files recently and came across a piece of paper that reminded me of another freedom for which we should pause to thank God. The spiritual freedom that Jesus won for us on the cross. The piece of paper that reminded me of this freedom was a prayer that a troubled teenager, who had been a prostitute and a drug addict, prayed during a United Methodist Church service while she was receiving help at Dubuque's Hillcrest Family Services' Residential Treatment Unit when I served as it's chaplain. She gave this prayer as a member of

the Hillcrest Ambassadors, a group of Hillcrest adolescent, court ordered residents who travelled to United Methodist Churches and led Sunday morning worship, sharing their testimonies about God's healing love at work in their lives. Hillcrest is a United Methodist supported agency. What follows is her prayer:

"Most gracious God, you are the Great Liberator. You come to us in our self-made prisons. The ones that keep us from loving you, our family and friends, strangers, and even ourselves, as you created us to do. And we confess that our prisons and the chains that hold us are not made of concrete and steel --- no, they are made of much stronger stuff. They are made out of fear and jealousy, anger and doubt, selfishness, temptation, and desire. These are the things that keep us chained down in life ---- these are the things that prevent us from freely tasting the sweetness of your love for us.

And that is why we give you thanks this morning, and every day God, because you know our condition --- our temptations and weaknesses, our sinfulness --- our brokenness. You know all about our unworthiness and yet you couldn't love us any less or any more than you already do! You love us God, and there is absolutely nothing we can do to change that fantastic, wonderful fact! All we can do is choose to accept or reject your Love. A love that comes again and again to us ---- to help us, to heal us, to forgive us, to make us feel better --- about things, and about ourselves. Lord, help us all here this morning to be open and receptive to your love as we are made more aware of you working in our lives for good, through your Holy Spirit and through the lives of other people who have been called by you, and have responded to your voice.

Bless us all in the task of discipleship Lord, that we would all live our lives on earth as eternal life is lived in heaven. In Jesus name we pray, Amen."
