



#### Strength for the Day

Ah, September! The beginning of all good things. The kids are back in school. Football is back on the telly. And as a church family, we are about to start --- The Story! The wonderful 31 week trek through the Bible --- the greatest love story of all time!

Starting September 10 Rally Sunday, I hope you'll join others in Sunday morning worship and again Tuesday evenings from 6:30 – 7:30 p.m. in the

West Fellowship Hall to hear, discuss, and learn The Story and your place in it. Ultimately, I hope you'll become so enthused about The Story that you'll want to share it with others!

Last week in worship we talked about the Upper Story, the Lower Story, and Your Story. The Upper Story is the Big Picture of God's word, the Bible, to us. Let me share with you a little of the "Upper Story" to help prepare you for this year.

The Bible is the self-communication of God --- to people --- to you and me. It is the self-revelation of God's mind, God's will, God's purpose and plan ---- and most importantly, God's infinite and relentless love for the world and all of humankind He has created.

The Bible is the quintessential love story in all of history. It's the story of a love so strong that it found expression in creating something and someone to love. It's the story of love lost, spurned, rejected. A story of a pursuing and protecting love that cares for, and promises to save, the one loved. A love story that can have a beautiful --- or a tragic ending, for each person who reads it.

So. How did this story come to be then? How did we receive the Bible --- this written word of God? What exactly is it --- this book?

Or, more precisely --- Book of books. You see, the Bible is a library ---- it contains almost every literary genre you'd care to read ---- historical documentary, narratives, poetry, letters, apocalyptic, parables, songs, sermons, wisdom sayings, and more, displayed in sixty-six separate writings, or "books", written over a period of between 1,000 and 1,500 years, depending upon which Biblical scholars you choose to believe.

Its authors include everyone from fisherman to Kings to judges and priests, shepherds and prophets, doctors and tax collectors, missionaries, prisoners and exiles.

The Bible is composed of two "Testaments" --- the Old and the New. A quick look at each.

The Old Testament: From its beginning account of our creation to have a loving and dependent relationship with God ---- and our free choice to reject this relationship --- the Old Testament is the story of God's never-ending love-in-action to keep his promise to reconcile us with Him. Beginning with the person of Abraham, a man chosen because of his faith to be the recipient of God's plan for the world's salvation ---- it is the story of God's choosing and growing and forming a nation of slaves into priests --- a nation who would carry, represent, and ultimately give birth to ---- the fulfillment of God's promise of salvation, in the person of Jesus Christ ---- the Son of God.

It tells the story of God's chosen people and their un-ending and unsuccessful struggle to live faithfully and consistently in a right relationship with their Creator. It also tells the story of the infinite faithfulness of God shown to his people, and His willingness and ability to use imperfect, and sometimes improbable, people to accomplish His perfect plan of salvation.

The New Testament was written in a very compressed time span compared to the Old, with all the books completed roughly between 50 and 100 A.D. It describes the fulfillment of God's promise and way of salvation for the world in the person and work of Jesus. It documents the grace-filled life, sacrificial and atoning death, and victorious resurrection of God's Son ---- it describes the beginning and spread of the early church throughout the known world ----- it shares letters from various church leaders to the first congregations about how to live a life of faithful discipleship in an often times "harsh" world ---- and ends with a final encouraging note of hope and assurance that God is in control, and that his power and love for us will ultimately prevail over the Evil in this world.




### Join us on September 17<sup>th</sup> as we begin "The Story"

## Did you know that Montgomery Street Preschool (MSPS) has been a valued ministry of our church

**for 50 plus years?** Starting in the early 1970's as Mom's Morning Out, the preschool evolved and moved into the church building in the early 80's when the name was changed to Montgomery Street Preschool. It became state licensed in 1993 and moved to its second floor location in 2003. Montgomery Street Preschool (MSPS) is the only faith based preschool remaining in Knoxville and is the only 2 year old preschool program in Marion County. MSPS prides itself on small class sizes with two teachers in

each room. Classes are available for 2, 3, and 4/5 year olds. Developing the whole child through hands on learning and experiences is what makes MSPS special. Tuition for MSPS pays our teacher salaries. Donations to MSPS, both monetary and items, are always accepted and your church giving can be directed to MSPS. We hope that MSPS will be part of our church for another 50 years or more!
