READ THE STORY. EXPERIENCE THE BIBLE.

AS YOU READ CHAPTER 2

This week read Chapter 2 of The Story! You can read The Story together or each read your own versions. We encourage you to find time to talk about what you are reading and pray together! The questions and prayers below can serve as a guide to great family discussion!

1. Have you ever had to do something completely new and follow instructions? If you had instructions that turned out to be wrong, how would you feel? We know God's instructions are perfect - so how does that make you feel about following his instructions, even when it's hard?

Prayer: God, you are awesome! We know your instructions are what's best for us. We ask for forgiveness for when we have not followed them. Help us to do our best to follow them! Amen.

2. What are some of the ways God worked in Abraham's life? (Giving him land, children, etc.)

Prayer: God, thank you for the example of Abraham. Help us to trust and have faith in you like Abraham! Amen.

3. How do you see God working in your life? (Finding something that was lost, a broken relationship mended, feeling better after being sick, an answered prayer, etc.)

Prayer: God, thank you for always being with us! Help us to see all the ways you are with us and give thanks for that. We love you! In Jesus name we pray, Amen.

4. Play "Simon Says." All players must obey "Simon." After the game or if the game isn't age appropriate, talk to your kids about people in their lives they are asked to obey. Examples would include: family members, teachers, etc.

Prayer: God, help us to trust and obey you in everything we do. Amen.

5. Have you ever read something in the Bible and thought, That's impossible! Is anything impossible for God?

Prayer: God, you are big! We know that you can do anything and that nothing is impossible for you! When we face tough things, help us to remember that and rely on you. Amen.
