AS YOU READ CHAPTER 30

This week we read Chapter 30 of The Story and learn more about Paul's life and his final days on earth.

1. Paul says he doesn't care if he has to go to prison - he wants to finish the work that God gave him, which is to witness to others about God's love. What are some ways you can show and tell others about God's love?

Prayer: God, we pray you help us see how we can talk to others about your love for them. We ask you help us to not be afraid but to know that's why you sent us to earth. Amen!

2. What kind of job do you want to do when you grow up? How can you serve God in that job?

Prayer: God, we pray that wherever you send us in life is where we will go. We pray that no matter what job we have we can speak openly about your love for us and others. We ask you to help us to not be afraid of others or to keep our faith secret. Amen!

3. The Holy Spirit protected Paul many times, but the Spirit also prompted Paul to go to Jerusalem where he knew he'd be arrested. Who also went to Jerusalem even though he knew he'd be arrested?

Prayer: God, thank you for teaching us about Jesus and Paul, who were both extremely faithful men. We pray you help us to learn through their stories that you will always be with us no matter where we are. Amen!

4. By being arrested, Paul got to share about Jesus with a lot of Romans. Do you think that's part of why God allowed Paul to be arrested?

Prayer: God, thank you for showing us that we can proclaim your word and love no matter where we are. Amen!

5. Can you always see how God's plans are going to turn out? Do you think God usually shows you his plan one step at a time?

Prayer: God, we pray we have faith in what you have planned for our lives. We ask you help us to learn to listen to you and to show us where you want us to go. Thank you for always protecting us and leading us to a great life. Amen!
