




## **Hospitality Treats**

## **Nothing Is Possible Without Jesus**



Understand why I have come. I did not come to abolish the law of Moses or the writings of the prophets. No, I came to fulfill them. I assure you, until heaven and earth disappear, even the smallest detail of God's law will remain until its purpose is achieved. So if you break the smallest commandment and teach others to do the same, you will be the least in the Kingdom of Heaven. But anyone who obeys God's laws and teaches them will be great in the kingdom of Heaven. But, I warn you—unless you obey God better than the teachers of religious law and the Pharisees, do, you can't enter the Kingdom of Heaven at all.

--Matthew 5:17-20

In this message, Jesus set the bar impossibly high for us. Just why would Jesus tell us that we have to do the impossible? Well, without Jesus, entering the Kingdom of Heaven, is of course, impossible. The point is that attaining eternal life is impossible for us to do on our own. We can't go it alone. God sent his Son, to Bethlehem and then Jesus willingly died upon the cross, to do for us what we are unable to do for ourselves. Therefore, mission: impossible. If it were possible to do on our own, then God wouldn't have sacrificed his Son, Jesus Christ, to achieve what we could have done alone, on our own. God's plan of Salvation, through our believing in Jesus, changes the mission from impossible to possible. Salvation is the ultimate gift from God. It is up to us individually to accept the gift and make God's eternal gift complete.
