#### **Peace Be With You!**




Have you imagined encountering the resurrected Jesus? We have been exploring individuals who met the resurrected Jesus through the Third Day sermon series. We have covered Mary, Peter, and Thomas, and next, we will address the two disciples who went to Emmaus and Paul. There is a common thread among them: they did not recognize Jesus right away. There are two possible reasons for this. One is that Jesus's appearance might have been different from before. The second is that, since they did not expect the resurrection of Jesus at all, they could not recognize

him at first. Including myself, many people wish to see the resurrected Jesus, even in a dream. I suppose that is what most Christians desire.

We have heard many stories about people who were transformed after encountering Jesus. However, as a pastor, I hope you do not chase that. You

may or may not see Jesus in your dreams. Regardless, what we can be sure of is that Jesus is with us through the power of the Holy Spirit. I mean that Jesus is already with us and in us until the end of the age, as Jesus promised in Matthew 28.

Another way we encounter Jesus is through the word of God. As we read Scripture, we meet the resurrected Jesus. The word of God is the living word. As we read, the Holy Spirit guides us to a deeper understanding of Jesus' teachings and helps us apply them to our lives. Thomas needed to meet Jesus and touch his wounds, but as Jesus mentioned, we are blessed to believe in the resurrected Jesus without seeing him or touching him.
